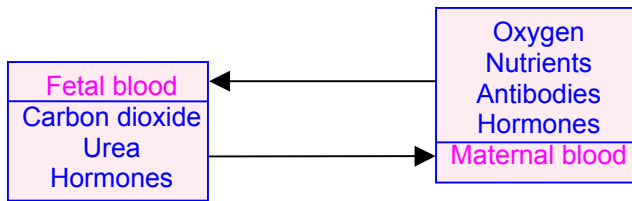


Note that the oxygenated blood is carried in the umbilical vein from the placenta to the fetus.

At birth the placenta separates where the blue and yellow layers meet.



Where is the acrosome?

Where are the cortical granules?

- The chorion forms the actual barrier between maternal and fetal blood;
- Chorion contains mitochondria for active transport of substances;
- A drop in the secretion of placental progesterone triggers birth.
